These ranged from local distilleries with a small fleet of vehicles, such as the Abhainn Dearg Distillery, to larger nationwide companies, such as IKEA and George Leslie Ltd, that operate fleets with hundreds of vehicles.

## The benefits

On average, our fleet reviews identify annual savings of:

- 178 tonnes of carbon dioxide equivalent and £43,000 per organisation.
- 8 tonnes of carbon dioxide equivalent and £4,000 per vehicle.

Fleet reviews are funded by Transport Scotland and are provided free of charge to organisations in Scotland.
