

Mobility and Scrappage Fund

Terms and conditions

About you

- Funds are only available to eligible households located within an eligible postcode.
 Eligible postcodes are:
 - within the lower quintile data zones of the Scottish Index of Multiple Deprivation (SIMD) that are **not** within 20km of a planned low emission zone
 - Scottish islands
 - within an Air Quality Management Area that is **not** within 20km of a planned low emission zone. Eligible applicants with postcodes within 20km of a low emission zone can apply for the Low Emission Zone Support Fund.
- Funds are only available to applicants in receipt of a means-tested or disability benefit as listed on the Energy Saving Trust website: <u>https://energysavingtrust.org.uk/grants-and-loans/mobility-and-scrappage-fund</u>
- 3. The fund is open to individuals for the disposal of personal vehicles only. It is not open to businesses, sole traders or for vehicles used for business purposes.
- 4. Funding is available for one eligible vehicle per property and per person.
- 5. Applicants must be aged 18 or over.

Your vehicle

- 6. Vehicles to be disposed of must be at or below the following Euro Standards:
 - Euro 3 or older petrol vehicles this generally applies to those registered before 2006
 - Euro 5 or older diesel vehicles this generally applies to those registered before September 2015



- 7. Applicants must have owned and have been named registered keeper of the vehicle for at least 12 months prior to applying to the fund.
- 8. Applicants must own the vehicle outright and therefore have the legal right to scrap the vehicle, with no outstanding finance remaining.

Grant conditions

- 9. The grant is offered on a first come, first served basis and is subject to available funding. Energy Saving Trust reserves the right to remove or amend this offer at any time.
- 10. A maximum grant to dispose of the vehicle is £2,000, this is available per household.
- Grants must be claimed by the deadline. If not, the funding will be withdrawn and reallocated to another applicant. Extension requests will be reviewed on a caseby-case basis.
 - a) Grant offers are valid for three months or by 12 March 2024, whichever occurs first.
 - b) If you wish to apply for a up to £1,000 Travel Better grant, your scrappage claim must be submitted and paid prior to the Travel Better on 14 February 2024, those unable to apply by this deadline will be unable to access this component of the fund.
- 12. You must notify Energy Saving Trust of your acceptance of the grant within 14 days of the offer being made or by 20 February 2024, whichever occurs first, or no funds will be allocated. To formally accept the grant a completed grant acceptance form must be submitted.
- 13. The grant is only paid in the form of a reimbursement upon scrappage of the vehicle and submission of a valid Certificate of Destruction from a SEPA licenced Authorised Treatment Facility based in Scotland to Energy Saving Trust.



- 14. Further funding under the Travel Better grant may be available to you and one other adult in your household once your claim for the disposal of your vehicle has been accepted, processed and paid.
- 15. Energy Saving Trust reserves the right to and will at its sole discretion assess on a case-by-case basis applications that fall outside any of the eligibility requirements set out in this form. Such applications will be assessed on their merits, bearing in mind the intent of the fund.

Vehicle disposal

- 16. You must not scrap your vehicle prior to being issued and accepting a grant offer letter. If you do so, or dispose of your vehicle by any other means, your application will be rejected.
- 17. You must scrap your vehicle at a SEPA licenced authorised treatment facility in Scotland. You can find here the full list of <u>authorised treatment facilities in Scotland</u>.

General

- 18. Energy Saving Trust is unable to accept any applications or third-party involvement on behalf of the applicant from representatives from any third party including but not limited to: vehicle sales, authorised treatment facilities, scrapyards, vehicle servicing and maintenance services or vehicle conversion/retrofitting services. Energy Saving Trust have the right to refuse any other third parties where a conflict of interest is found.
- 19. All information you provide on the application and in any subsequent interactions with Energy Saving Trust must be correct and accurate. If you are unable to or subsequently fail to meet any of these criteria, your application will not be progressed.
- 20. If you are found to have breached any criteria after your grant has been paid, you will be required to repay the funding amount in full.
- 21. If any information provided in relation to this application is subsequently found to be untrue, inaccurate, or incomplete, this may invalidate the entire application.



- 22. You must notify Energy Saving Trust at <u>mobilityfund@est.org.uk</u> without delay if at any time after this application is submitted there is any material change to any of this information, in particular to any information that would affect eligibility for any grant under the fund. The information made available by Energy Saving Trust on its website and elsewhere in relation to the grant fund and more generally in relation to vehicles is intended to act as a guide only, and accordingly Energy Saving Trust cannot and does not accept any liability for any loss or damage that you may suffer as a result of using that information.
- 23. Energy Saving Trust and/or the Scottish Government reserves the right, at its sole and absolute discretion and at any time, to change any of the eligibility requirements set out in this form and/or to introduce new or additional terms and conditions on giving notice to you.
- 24. Should the Scottish Government discontinue the grant fund, applicants who have received a formal written grant offer from Energy Saving Trust will still be entitled to receive payment of the grant, assuming they still meet the eligibility requirement for the fund and the offer is in date.
- 25. Energy Saving Trust reserves the right in consultation with the Scottish Government to suspend or reject grant applications at any time where a formal written grant offer has not been signed and returned, including where there are insufficient funds available to provide to all applicants.
- 26. Energy Saving Trust reserves the right to reject any application for a grant and Energy Saving Trust's decision as to whether an applicant is eligible for a grant will be final. Energy Saving Trust may seek further information to determine eligibility and you must provide this information within the specified time frame if you wish to continue with the application. Neither Energy Saving Trust nor any of its officers, employees, agents or subcontractors shall be liable for any losses, damages or costs suffered by you which arise out of or in connection with the application process whether caused by the negligence of Energy Saving Trust, any of Energy Saving Trust's officers, employees, agents or subcontractors or otherwise.
- 27. The arrangements applicable to this fund will be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of Scotland and will be subject to the non-exclusive jurisdiction of the Scottish Courts.



28. Failure to meet terms and conditions will result in your offer being withdrawn.

Data protection:

- 29. To monitor and administer the Mobility and Scrappage Fund, we need to process your personal data. This may include passing your data to Transport Scotland (an agency of the Scottish Government), Audit Scotland and other funding bodies who will process it solely for the purposes of administering and auditing this fund.
- 30. By submitting your application, you acknowledge and agree that we may make searches at fraud prevention agencies who will supply us with your personal data. We may also share your personal data with financial and other organisations involved in fraud prevention to protect ourselves and others from theft and fraud. If you give us false or inaccurate information and we suspect fraud, we will record this. We and other third parties may use this information if decisions are made about you or others at your address(es) on credit or credit-related services or motor, household, credit, life or any other insurance facilities. It may also be used for tracing and claims assessment.
- 31. By submitting an application, you give permission for Energy Saving Trust to verify your evidence with the DWP and/or DVLA as required.
- 32. Energy Saving Trust may contact you in the future to assess customer satisfaction, participation in case studies or carry out evaluation of the fund.
