### 1. Organisational information

  - Tell us how many young people you plan to engage and the approximate breakdown of age ranges.
  - Tell us about the inequalities they face in relation to taking action on the climate emergency.
  - Tell us the geographical areas you plan to deliver in.
- Tell us how you would use the Sustainable Youth framework to support youth led action on climate change.
  - Please ensure you have read the Sustainable Youth framework before completing this form.
  - The framework is designed to offer structure and support but is flexible to adapt to your delivery model and the young people you work with.



- How do you put children and young people at the centre of your work as an organisation?
  - For example, please explain how young people take the lead on deciding the actions and projects they wish to undertake, and how they are actively involved in the strategy and running of the organisation.
  
- How will you capture learning and demonstrate impact?
  - Please note we are only asking for this to be proportionate to the size of grant and something that is useful to you also. We currently ask for six monthly update reports on progress and learning as well as sharing any stories/case studies.
  
- Tell us how you keep the children and young people you work with safe.
  - Include mention of your safeguarding policy and any designated safeguarding roles within your organisation. Describe how safeguarding is integrated into your work and any specific issues that may be relevant to this funding application. Shortlisted applications will be asked to provide further details on their approach to safeguarding.
  
- Funding request
  - Please provide a top-line summary of the main areas of planned budget spend. Include no more than ten lines of expenditure – multiple areas of spend can be combined as appropriate. For example, if you need to purchase paper and pens, please group under a heading such as project resources.
  - Please note organisations can apply for core organisational costs up to 25% of your total funding ask. We encourage all applicants to include these costs- please make sure this is a separate budget line.
  - Please also ensure you include costs related to attending the one-day training with Ulster Wildlife. Please note this does not need to be a separate heading but include within relevant budget line (e.g., staff time).
